



Getting Started

Before you begin, please make sure that you have a computer network with 2.4GHz WiFi, 5GHz WiFi or Ethernet available and one of the following devices:

An Apple[®] iPhone[®], iPod[®], or iPad[®] running iOS 7 or greater An Android smartphone or tablet running version 4.0 or greater A PC with WiFi adapter running Windows 7 or greater A Mac[®] computer with AirPort[®] card running OS X[®] 10.7 or greater

Controls and Connections






- 1. Status Lights: See page 2 for a full description of the status light indicators.
- 2. Power Button: To turn on the AxiomAir, press and release the power button. To turn off the system, press the power button briefly and the AxiomAir will safely shutdown in about 20 seconds. If the system should become unresponsive for any reason, simply press and hold the power button until the green LED turns off (this can take over 30 seconds).
- 3. Power Input: Plug the round connector from the supplied power brick into this jack.
- 4. Input Source Selector: Press to switch between digital, analog, optical, and Bluetooth input sources.
- **5.** Input Status Indicators: Displays which input source is currently active. (Left to right wireless / analog / optical).
- **6.** Analog Input: An external playback device with a line or headphone output can be connected to the AxiomAir system using this 3.5mm stereo input jack. To select the analog input, click on the gear icon in the top right corner of the web interface and click the ANALOG button. You can also use the back panel button (4. Above) to cycle through to the analog input.
- 7. Optical Input: An external playback device with an optical output can be connected to the AxiomAir system using this optical input jack. To select the optical input, click on the gear icon in the top right corner of the web interface and click the OPTICAL button. You can also use the back panel button (4. Above) to cycle through to the optical input.
- **8.** USB Ports: Any of the group of four USBs can be used to attach external USB thumb drives for music playback. Note that one USB port is populated with a Bluetooth adapter. If you remove this device Bluetooth will no longer be available. If you reinsert this device and reboot your AxiomAir, Bluetooth will be available again. **Do not attempt to charge your portable device using these ports as it may cause the AxiomAir to shutdown.**
- **9.** Ethernet Port: Can be used to connect to a wired LAN.



Volume Buttons

These buttons allow to adjust the volume up or down and mute the volume without having to go to the User Interface. Note: these buttons will not be functional when AirPlay is in use.

Connect to Power

Place your AxiomAir in a location where you'd like to enjoy your music.

Plug the round connector from the supplied power brick to the jack marked 15VDC IN on the back of your AxiomAir.

Plug the supplied power cable into the power brick and then into a nearby wall outlet.

Optional: If you are connecting to a wired network plug in an

Ethernet cable. Do not connect an Ethernet cable if you'd like to connect your AxiomAir to a wireless network

Turn On

Press the right button at the bottom front of the AxiomAir. You should see a green LED illuminate.

In approximately 45 seconds you will hear a xylophone start-up sound, followed by a flashing blue LED, indicating that the system is in hotspot mode and ready to be added to your home WiFi network.

Section 1 - iOS

1. Open WiFi settings. Your AxiomAir will appear under the caption "SET UP NEW AIRPLAY SPEAKER" as AxiomAir-xxxxxx.



2. Tap AxiomAir-xxxxxx. Select the desired wireless network. Tap on the speaker name and give your speaker a unique name. This name will be used whenever you want to access the AxiomAir. Tap Next on the AirPlay Setup screen.



3. Your AxiomAir will join your WiFi network. Once successfully connected to your own WiFi network, the blue LED on the front of your AxiomAir will stop flashing and you will hear the xylophone startup sound.

Your system is now ready to play!



PLAYING A SONG (iOS12):

Slide down "Control Center" from the top of the screen and tap the AirPlay icon. Select the speaker from the list. Return to your music app and tap Play.

PLAYING A SONG (iOS11):

Slide up "Control Center" from the bottom of the screen and swipe across until you locate the media player box (seen here in the top right location of the screen). Hard press the media player box and tap the airplay icon. Select the speaker from

the list. Return to your music app and tap Play.

PLAYING A SONG (iOS9 - iOS10):

Slide up "Control Center" from the bottom of the screen (iOS9 and earlier) and swipe left (iOS10).

Tap AirPlay (iOS9 and earlier) or click the pull down at the bottom of the pop-up screen (iOS10).

Select the speaker from the list and tap Done.

Return to your music app and tap Play.



Accessing the User Interface:

Once the AxiomAir is connected to your network you can access the user interface by downloading the latest AxiomAir App from the App Store. Make sure your device is connected to the same network as the AxiomAir and the AxiomAir is turned on. Open the AxiomAir App to access the user interface.


You can also access the user face from any web browser by entering http://axiomair-xxxxxx.local/ in the address bar where axiomair-xxxxxx is the speaker name.

Section 2 - Android

1. Download the latest AxiomAir app from Google Play at https://play.google.com/store/apps/details?id=volumio.browser. AxiomAir



2. Open WiFi settings. Connect to the AxiomAir-xxxxxx network (no password is required).



3. Once connected, open the AxiomAir App.Tap the gear icon in the top right corner.



4. Tap on Network.



5. Under the list of available wireless networks, tap the connect button beside the network you wish to join.

Enter your network password and tap Connect.


Once successfully connected to your own WiFi network, the blue LED on the front of your AxiomAir will stop flashing.
Your system is now ready to play!



PLAYING A SONG:

Spotify: Play directly from the Spotify app by selecting your AxiomAir from the available devices menu. (Premium subscription required).

You can also open your UPnP compatible music player (eg. BubbleUPnP, UPnPlay).
Select AxiomAir as your Renderer.
Select your music and press play.





1. Open Network Settings. Connect to the AxiomAir -xxxxxx network (no password is required).

Once connected to the AxiomAir hotspot you have three ways to access the WebUI:

- 1. Open File Explorer click on Network on the left side then double click on the AxiomAir on the right side.
- 2. Open a browser and enter http://axiomair.local/in the address bar to open the AxiomAir WebUI. (Note: the page will fail to load using http://axiomair.local/if your PC does not have a program called Bonjour installed. To get Bonjour download Apple iTunes as it is included)
- 3. Open a browser and enter 192.168.211.1 in the address bar. This is the AxiomAir Hotspot IP address. It will only work when your AxiomAir is in Hotspot mode, once you are connected to your network this method of getting to the WebUI will no longer work as your router will assign a new IP address to your AxiomAir.


2. Click on the gear icon in the top right corner.

Click on Network.
Under the list of available wireless networks, click on the connect button beside the network you wish to join.



3. Enter your network password and click on Connect.

Once successfully connected to your own WiFi network, the blue LED on the front of your AxiomAir will stop flashing. Press F5 in your

PLAYING A SONG with Windows Media Player:

For Windows 7, 8, 8.1, and 10

Open Windows Media Player.

In the Stream tab, make sure "Automatically allow devices to play my media" is selected and that your system is set to allow media sharing.

Select your music, select AxiomAir as the PlayTo device, and press play.

PLAYING A SONG with iTunes:

Open iTunes. Click on the AirPlay icon on the top of the toolbar. Click on AxiomAir. The AirPlay icon will turn blue. Select your music and press play.

PLAYING A SONG with Spotify (requires premium subscription):


Open Spotify. Click on the Devices button beside the volume control and select AxiomAir. Select your music and press play.

Section 4 - Mac Computer

1. Choose Wi-Fi on your Mac. Your AxiomAir will appear under the caption "SET UP NEW AIRPLAY SPEAKER" as AxiomAir-xxxxxx.



2. Select the wireless network you would like your AxiomAir to join. Click on the speaker name and give your speaker a unique name. This name will be used whenever you want to access the AxiomAir. Click next. If prompted enter the network password.



3. Your AxiomAir will join your WiFi network. Once successfully connected to your own WiFi network, the blue LED on the front of your AxiomAir will stop flashing and you will hear the xylophone startup sound.

Your system is now ready to play!



PLAYING A SONG with iTunes:

Open iTunes. Click on the AirPlay icon on the top of the toolbar.



Click on AxiomAir. The AirPlay icon will turn blue. Select your music and press play.

Accessing the User Interface:

Once the AxiomAir is connected to your network you can access the user interface by opening any web browser and entering http://axiomair-xxxxxx.local/ in the address bar where axiomair-xxxxxx is the speaker name.



Using In Other Locations

There are many places where you might want to enjoy music on your AxiomAir that are out of range of or lacking a usable WiFi network: at the dock, on the beach, on a camping trip, etc. To make sure that you can still enjoy your music, the AxiomAir has two ways you can connect. One is using Bluetooth and the other is to use the built-in WiFi hotspot which automatically becomes active when out of range of your home network. This is signified by flashing blue and red LEDs. When the hotspot is available, your AxiomAir will appear as an available WiFi network on your device's WiFi or network settings. To connect to the AxiomAir WiFi hotspot, simply join the AxiomAirxxxxxx network. On iOS devices, a Safari window will automatically open to our WebUI. Tap "Cancel" in the top right corner and a pop-up will appear. Tap "Use Without Internet" and then close the web page. Once connected you will be able to play music using the same method used when you were connected to your home network

Using Wired DevicesIf you'd like to use an audio source with your AxiomAir that does not have wireless capability, your AxiomAir has both a 3.5mm analog input jack and an Optical input jack. To use the analog or optical input, simply connect your source to the analog or optical input jack with an appropriate cable. You have two ways to control your device; either from the buttons on your AxiomAir or from the AxiomAir User Interface. To use the buttons you can push the Input selection button on the front of your AxiomAir until you are in Analog or Optical mode and then control the volume with the buttons on top of your AxiomAir. From the AxiomAir User Interface in the top right corner of the page, tap or click on the gear icon. In the menu pop-up, click the input you want to be on. The analog or optical input will now be active and the volume can be controlled using either the volume slider in the User Interface or the buttons on top of your AxiomAir.

Playing to Multiple AxiomAirs

If you have more than one AxiomAir and would like to play the same music on multiple devices, a Playback Group can be created. To do this, navigate to the Playback page of the AxiomAir WebUI. At the bottom of the page you will see all the AxiomAir systems that are available on your network (Note: all systems must be powered on and connected to the same WiFi network and each system should be given a unique name). Click on the AxiomAir with access to the music that you'd like to play and start playback. Next click on the Edit Group button on the right side of the Playback page. You will now see each available AxiomAir listed on a new page and the system currently playing music will show the track information next to Now Playing. To create a group, simply click and hold on the system you'd like to group and drag it on top of the system with music currently playing. You will see the single "Axiom A" icon change to two icons. Each system will now have its own volume control slider to allow the volume of each individual system to be changed. Additional systems may be added to the group by dragging and dropping onto the group as described above. Any individual system can be removed from the group at any time by clicking the trash bin icon next to that system.



Turning Off Your AxiomAir

Your AxiomAir contains a computer, and computers need to be shut down properly. When you're finished listening to your AxiomAir and wish to turn it off, simply press the white power button. After approximately 20 seconds the green power LED will turn off, indicating the system has turned off.

Note: Avoid unplugging your AxiomAir before shutting it down as shown above.

Tips and Troubleshooting

Best Locations for your AxiomAir

- Place your AxiomAir in an open area where there are few obstructions and away from metallic surfaces.
- Avoid placing your AxiomAir behind furniture or inside cabinets.
- Avoid placing your AxiomAir near microwave ovens, cordless phones, or other sources of electrical or radio interference.

Problems and Solutions

If you experience dropouts or stuttering:

- Try locating your AxiomAir and/or the device you are using to play music closer to your WiFi router.
- Check to see if any devices are being used that could be creating interference (microwave ovens, cordless phones, etc.).
- Check to see if your WiFi network is under high usage.
- Prioritize your AxiomAir in your router settings (check with your router manufacturer for details).
- Add a WiFi repeater to extend WiFi signal coverage.

If your AxiomAir isn't responding or cannot be seen from your devices:

- Press the white power button once and wait until the green light extinguishes. Press the power button again to re-start.
- If the green light fails to extinguish above, press and hold the white power button until the green light extinguishes (approx. 20 seconds). Press the power button again to re-start.

To update your AxiomAir software:

- Open the AxiomAir User Interface.
- In the top right corner of the page, tap or click on the gear icon. In the menu pop-up, select System.
- Tap or click on Check Updates. If an update is available, follow the prompts to update your system.

To reset your AxiomAir to its factory settings:

- Open the AxiomAir User Interface.
- In the top right corner of the page, tap or click on the gear icon. In the menu pop-up, select System.
- Tap or click on Factory Settings and follow the prompts. Note: doing this will cause your AxiomAir to lose all its memory
 of your Network settings and Playlists.
